## ECG/EKG Technician Certification Program

The RCI's comprehensive 50-hour ECG/EKG National Technician Certification Program prepares students for a rewarding career as an ECG/EKG Technician. This course will include learning about important practices and background information on the anatomy and physiology of the heart, medical disease processes, medical terminology, medical ethics, legal aspects of patient contact, the Holter monitor, 12-Lead, electrocardiography and echocardiography.

Additionally, students will practice with industry specific testing equipment and perform hands-on lab sessions including an introduction to the function and proper use of the ECG/EKG machine. Also, the proper placement of leads onto the anatomy of the chest wall.

The ECG/EKG Technician Certification Program includes a graded final exam to help prepare students for the National ECG/EKG Technician Exam.

An ECG/EKG Certification can also be a valuable addition to already working medical professionals. Phlebotomist (CPT1), Medical Assistant (MA), Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN), and many more can benefit greatly from having their own ECG/EKG Certificate.

### Requirements / Prerequisites
